## Ritual Intent to Compete Declaration

**NOTE:** Ritual Competition will be held on Saturday, March 26, 2011 beginning at 10 a.m. Specific Chapter times will be assigned once all registration information is complete.

Chapters will compete in opening and closing, both degrees. Times will be determined when we know how many chapters will be competing.

Included: Opening prayer and Nine o'clock Interpolation as the closing prayer. Officers can start at stations or can assemble with triangle. Your Chapter will be judged accordingly. The pledge of secrecy and welcoming guests are also optional.

Minimum dress is dress shirt, pants, dress shoes (NO sneakers), ties, well groomed.

Chapters will compete for Gold, Silver, and Bronze certificates - Gold certificate = at least a 90% score between word accuracy, floor work, and overall presentation. Silver certificate = at least an 80% score between word accuracy, floor work, and overall presentation. Bronze certificate = at least a 70% score between word accuracy, floor work, and overall presentation

Chapters will be judged by a team of five judges. Two judges for verbal accuracy. One judge for floor work. One judge for presentation (voice clarity and projection). One judge for overall impression

Competing Chapters must have a minimum of 6 officers. Officers do not have to be the most current, such as the MC who just got installed. This is at the chapter's discretion. Your Chapter does need to have: MC, SC, JC, SD, JD (can double as steward/s), Marshal (can double as Chaplain). Sentinel part can be presented by an Advisor or omitted, however JD must do his part (including door knocks).

Substitutions: A Chapter can substitute for any office except the MC, SC, or JC. State Officers are allowed to substitute at any chapter for any reasonable situation. (The State Ritual Director will be the final authority on this matter.)

The top three chapters and any other chapter that scores at least a Silver certificate will qualify to compete at the Region 1 Ritual Competition in Lowell on May 14th.
